We provide printed material to help individuals and organizations advocate for the installation of heaving loops and LNM representatives are available to discuss the basics of the technology and its benefits to those with heaving loss through meetings with individuals or groups. We offer power point presentations that can be tailored to the specific concerns of various types of venues from churches to legislative chambers, the specific concerns of various places where people congregate.
